



NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT (HIA)

APPLICATION IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL HERITAGE RESOURCES ACT, 1999 (ACT 25 OF 1999)

A submission to Heritage Western Cape is being made, in terms of S.38(4) of the NHRA, for the proposed subdivision and redevelopment of Remainder of Consolidated Erf 1424, Main Road Sea Point.

Description of the work to be done: This draft Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) considers the possible heritage impacts of the proposed residentially led, mixed use development including affordable housing on the 353 on Main (Tafelberg) Precinct, and Sea Point more widely.

Invitation to comment: Members of the public and interested and affected parties are invited to comment on the draft HIA and specialist reports for the proposed plan for the 353 on Main (Tafelberg) Precinct.
