The **Western Cape Government (WCG) Department of Infrastructure** is inviting suitably qualified applicants residing within the Garden Route, Heidelberg Municipality to apply for a funded Work-based Programme.

THIS PROGRAMME INCLUDES WORK IN THE FOLLOWING FIELDS:

- Waste Management
- Roadwork Maintenance
- Building Maintenance

PROGRAMME PURPOSE:

- Equip unemployed youth with skills needed in the built environment. Provide paid workplace training aligning with EPWP National Youth Service (NYS) principles. Strengthen youth participation in infrastructure delivery.

PREFERENCE:

- Work Experience in Waste Management, Roadworks Maintenance and Building Maintenance will be an advantage.
- Persons with disability and women are encouraged to apply.
- Heidelberg residents.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Be South African citizens
- Have a valid ID document
- Must have good health
- Not in employment or in education.
- Be between the ages of 18 – 35 years
- Grade 9 / NQF Level 1

COMPETENCIES:

- Practical Skills, Literacy Skills (reading and writing ability). General knowledge of the built environment.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful applicants will be required to work on a Municipality/Satellite site as part of the work-based programme. Successful applicants will be required to sign a contract with the Department.

STIPEND:

- Successful applicants will receive a monthly stipend of R4500.

NB:

- Applicants can use facilities at a local Library, Thusong Centre, E-Centre Youth Café or Internet Café OR personal smartphones to register on the SA Youth.Mobi platform.
- Shortlisted candidates will be requested to upload certified copies of their IDs and highest education certificate on the SAYouth.Mobi site when requested by the Department Infrastructure.
