- Practical Skills, Literacy Skills (reading and writing ability).
- General knowledge of the built environment.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful applicants will be required to work on a Municipality/Satellite site as part of the work-based programme.
- Successful applicants will be required to sign a contract with the Department.

STIPEND:

- Successful applicants will receive a monthly stipend of R4 500.00
