Due to numerous additional slips and significant bridge damage the Franschhoek Pass is closed for **ALL** traffic (**light motor vehicles, heavy motor vehicles, motorcycles, pedestrians, cyclists**).

Vehicles will be stopped at the end of Franschhoek Town closest to the mountain side and at the T-Junction at the Theewaterskloof dam.

Vehicles are required to make use of alternative routes. Resident access to La Rochelle and Karmel only via **Franschhoek**.

No exceptions will be allowed.
